NEBS Newsletter Editorial

Most editorials at this time of the year cover breeding preparation and the past shows so I thought we could do something different this year.

I would like to update members on the changes by the ANBC that are approved and/or prepared for implementation in the future –

Ring Issue Date will revert to January 1st however no implementation year date can be set until the ring maker is contacted and the ANBC can get confirmation from them. It certainly will not be until at least 2015 as we already have our 2014 rings on order. South Australia voted against this action as we will now have to revert to showing birds that are mostly less than 12 months old given our weather patterns. This will not give the lesser varieties time to fully mature for the National show.

ANBC National Show Date will be changed again back to the 4th Friday in May from 2016. That lead time is required as arrangements have already been made by both WA and Tasmania in venue bookings.

Show Cage Perches will revert to 12mm at the conclusion of the 2015 Nationals and this will mean cages used for the Nationals will all have this standard perch fitted. Given SA was by far the most advanced with the change the BCSA will need to assess our states position regarding this matter.

Two Bird Three Bird Trial – a motion has been advised by Tasmania that they will seek to approve in June 2014 the three birds benched with two for points process and also ask states to vote individually on the new classes that have and will again be trialed.

Standard Matters -

Suffused class will now be correctly called Dilutes.

Grey Series will be allowed within the Blackeye class however the colour of Buttercup yellow will be the prominent feature of this variety.

The two Yellow Faced Blue variants will now be called Australian Golden Face and Yellow Face.

We will keep you informed as matters are confirmed.

SHOW SCHEDULE FOR MONTHLY NIGHT SHOWS 2013-2014

Class 1	Normals (GreenSeries, Blue Series, Normal English Yellowfaced Blue Series & Normal Double Factor Australian Yellowfaced Blue Series)
Class 2	Suffused, Blackeyed Self, Clearwing, Greywing, Fallow & Recessive Pied
Class 3	Lutino, Albino, Cinnamonwing, Opaline ASC & AOSV, Clearbody & Lacewing
Class 4	Spangle Double Factor, Spangle ASC & AOSV & Dominant Pied
Class 5	Crested, Darkeyed Clear, Darkwing & Saddleback

NO ENTRY FEE. No double rung birds except for unbroken caps

Note that classes 2-5 now include the four colours: Green, Blue, English yellowfaced blue and Double Factor Australian yellowfaced blue

Sections for Junior, Novice, Intermediate and Open. Owner bred Young birds rung with the two latest ring colours are to be exhibited together. UBCs will be judged separately and for them ring colour is immaterial. Old birds will not accrue points

Young birds rung with the earlier of the two latest ring colours cease to be eligible as Young birds on **September 1** of each year. For example, gold rung birds cease to exist as Young birds on September 1, 2013

Points will be accrued monthly at the club night shows (except at Mini Shows & Derby and Oaks) for both Young (as defined above) and UBCs. $1^{st} = 3$ points, $2^{nd} = 2$ points, $3^{rd} = 1$ point

Bird of the night will be awarded a certificate and be chosen from Young birds, except for October and November, when bird of the night will be chosen from UBCs

Best bird of each status will be awarded a certificate and be chosen from Young birds, except for October and November when best of each status will be chosen from UBCs

At the end of each calendar year the member with the highest aggregate points in each Section will be awarded a \$30 Trading Table Voucher or a Show Cage. **To be eligible a member must show birds at a minimum of three monthly night shows**

HOT WEATHER POLICY: If on the previous evening the temperature forecast is **above**32 degrees NO BIRDS WILL BE BENCHED



To all BCSA members;

The ANBC would like to get feedback from their State / Zone bodies on what might be deemed as MAJOR faults within the attached document.

Once identified, it would be advantages to nominate if the thought was to DISQUALIFY or treat differently or the same any of these identified faults

I will give three examples that might be considered:

Flecking:

Major fault – should be removed from the bench (Disqualify). Need to phase in the total disqualification in steps over a 5 year period

Missing Flights:

Major fault – if more than 4 flights missing collectively regardless of placement (Disqualify). Need to phase in the total disqualification over a 2 year period

Missing Flights:

Fault – if up to 4 missing collectively (Penalty)

The above are a guide only for standardising the submissions to me from those that wish to respond.

The cut off date we shall make the 10th of September so this gives all fanciers some time to consider.

It might be that other items not listed could be included

Variety

Disqualification

- Birds entered in the wrong class:
 - Includes birds showing characteristics other than those described in *The Standard* for the variety they represent
 - o Combination of Cinnamon with Clearwing and Greywing.
 - Blackeyed Selfs with grey cheek patches
 - Entries in the Dominant Pied Class with ground colour spot only on back of head or other part of the body

• Eyes:

Varieties without a clearly visible iris ring where required in *The Standard*

Varieties with a visible iris ring where the absence of an iris ring is required in *The Standard*

Penalty

- Birds of any variety with:
 - Head Flecking The heavier the flecking, the greater the penalty
 - Incorrect coloured cheek patches, other than birds entered in the wrong class
 - o Ground colour spot on back of head or other part of the body other than as permitted in *The Standard*.
 - Incorrect iris ring colour not white
 - o Incorrect cere colour for the variety as described in *The Standard*
 - o Cleft, shallow or narrow masks
 - o Missing (or extra) spots where *The Standard* requires six.
 - o Spots where *The Standard* requires none.
 - Spots incorrectly presented as required in The Standard
 - o Feather disturbances ruffle in neck or chest area
 - Wing colour and/or markings not as described in *The Standard*
 - Long flighted and/or heavy secondary flight feather characteristics
 - Incorrect tail feather or tail quill colour within the parameters of the variety other than the Disqualifiable characteristics
 - o Length of primary tail feathers not in proportion to the bird
 - o Departure from varietal features as set out in *The Standard*

- Red eyed self colours with markings on the head, back of neck and wings - the heavier the markings, the heavier the penalty
- Clearwings that do not have clear & pure ground colour on wings with absence of markings as described in *The Standard* - the heavier the markings the greater the penalty
- o Greywings that have body colour and wing markings varying from that required in *The Standard* the greater the departure the greater the penalty
- Self coloured birds, Spangle Double Factor and Lacewings with body colour suffusion
- o Opalines not showing a clear 'V' effect in mantle or with inadequate wing markings
- Apart from Opalines, birds showing body colour on wings, back or neck
- Dominant Pieds showing incorrect markings as defined in *The Standard* for that variety of Pied.
- Danish-Recessive Pieds with barring above the cere and / or wing markings greater or less than that as required in *The Standard* - the greater the departure the greater the penalty
- Crested where a bird has multiple crests, crest off centre or has a crest or feather disturbance outside of the areas allowed for in *The* Standard
- Suffused Dilutes that have body colour and wing markings greater or less than that required in *The Standard* – the greater the departure the greater the penalty

Inappropriate or Illegal act by an exhibitor or team carer/s. Also refer Format & Rules for the ANBC Annual Championship Shows

Disqualification

- Any evidence of trimming (other than spots) or of dying or bleaching of feathers. Any practice that is deemed to be unfair including the tampering with rings.
- Double ringing, be it plastic or metal.
- Rings other than the correct coloured ring marked with the year & ANBC Secretary's nominated symbol.

Change to the BCSA Status Movement Rules

Novice Section: A member when first joining a BCSA Affiliate / Associate Society must show in the Novice Section and will remain in this section until such time as the member has gained 20 points from recognised shows with at least three different owner bred birds within a 3 year period. Once the points have been achieved the member will automatically be elevated to Intermediate Section on January 1_{st} of the following year.

A Novice can also apply to be promoted after 5 years if not promoted by points within that period. Promotion is to be conditional on an assessment of the overall competiveness of their birds by BCSA nominated judges. The commencement of the five year period is retrospective to the commencement of the Status Movement Process in 2010.
